GRANDPARENTS DAY CRAFTS FOR AT HOME

Hello Parents! I want to thank you all for having such patient and well-mannered children! As you know, we weren't able to have grandparents in the building for this past Thursday's Grandparents Workshop, and I am proud to say that every student did so well! As we progressed from project to project, there were several times when they had to wait for paint, glue, etc., and every child was on their best behavior, all day. And their projects turned out so cute!

We are sending home a Ziploc bag with a few projects for you to enjoy at home. I apologize in advance- the Nativity craft has a lot of pieces and the instructions are all in 4 black and white pictures. I think if you lay it all out on the clear plastic backing, before gluing, it should be easier. I really didn't know it would be so vague when I picked it out!

The white papers with the outlines and words are patterns for an Advent wreath with candles. The instructions are rather easy for this one- color the candles first, and if you have them, wrap and glue or tape around a cardboard tube. The flame can be tucked inside until it's time for it to be "lit". A paper plate makes a great base for the wreath, and you will probably want to trace out more leaves and holly berries to decorate it.
