Sunday School Invitation for Emmaus Lutheran

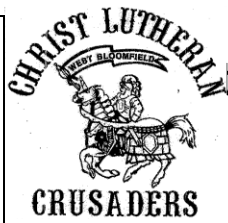
Emmaus Lutheran and Christ Lutheran churches will start the year with having Sunday School together. Any child can attend Sunday school at either church depending on the schedule.
